Position	Middle Primary Teacher in 1:1 iPad Classroom – Fulltime Ongoing to begin 1 January 2018

We are seeking a dynamic and enthusiastic teacher to join our teaching staff in Term 1 2018. This is an opportunity to join a school where the focus is on working with every student to reach their very finest potential in all aspects of their development. In 2018, Sacred Heart will implement a 1:1 iPad program beginning in Year Four.

This is a full time ongoing position commencing 1 January 2018.

Sacred Heart is a double stream co-educational school with 460 students from Kindergarten – Year 6. The school community has the benefit of having onsite an Early Learning Centre catering for 2 – 5 ½ year olds and an Out of School Hours Care service. The school enjoys a close relationship with the Parish and strong support from the parent community.

Selection Criteria:

Applications are invited from enthusiastic and innovative educators with the following attributes:

- Possess demonstrated excellence in teaching and classroom management as a dynamic, innovative and reflective practitioner who strives for excellence and exhibits a desire to assist each student to achieve their potential;
- An understanding of and the ability to differentiate the teaching and learning program to cater for a variety of student needs;
- Ability to analyse and use data to inform teaching and learning practises to raise student levels of achievement;
- Demonstrate a high level of interpersonal and organisational skills and the ability to work collaboratively with staff, students and parents in developing a harmonious community atmosphere;
- Be a positive, reflective and enthusiastic teacher who demonstrates initiative;
- Demonstrate a sound understanding of outcomes based education and the Western Australian Curriculum;
- Be highly proficient in the use of ICT skills and successfully integrate ICT, especially iPads and Mac Books, into the curriculum to engage, motivate and improve teaching and learning;
- Knowledge and application of 21st Century Learning Pedagogy;
- Significant teaching experience in a 1:1 classroom;
- Model the successful implementation of 21st Century Learning Pedagogy for staff;
- Demonstrate a high degree of professionalism and a desire to continue to improve.

Applicants must include in their application a digital artefact that demonstrates how they integrate technology in their classroom and how they use technology to engage, extend and differentiate for

individual needs. Reference to the SAMR model and how this is used in the classroom setting to improve students learning will be advantageous.

Qualification/s Required:

- Exhibit an active personal witness to the Catholic Faith (Please attach Priest reference);
- Relevant four year tertiary qualification and
- Accreditation to Teach Religious Education Learning Area, or the ability to achieve Accreditation to Teach Religious Education

Applicants must have a current registration as a teacher with the Teachers Registration Board of WA (TRBWA) to be eligible for appointment. Information is available on www.trb.wa.gov.au

Applicants must be fully supportive of the objectives and ethos of Catholic education.

Applicants must submit curriculum vitae, addressed to the Principal, including the names and contact numbers of three referees, one of whom must be the current employer. A current Federal Police Clearance/100 Point Identification Check must also be included. The appropriate Criminal History Record Check form is available from the Department of Education and Training website (www.det.wa.edu.au). In the case of teachers, a current Teachers Registration Board of West Australian (TRBWA) registration number shall be provided in lieu, as ongoing registration requires a current Police Clearance.

On appointment successful applicants will require a Working With Children Check. Application forms are available at certain Australia Post outlets throughout the state.
