CONTEXTUAL INFORMATION

Sacred Heart Primary School is a double stream Catholic co-educational school catering for students from Kindergarten to Year Six. Respect, Reverence, Responsibility and Resilience are central to the vision of the school helping us to integrate faith into our daily life through the school motto 'God is Love'.

Sacred Heart offers a holistic education with strong academic, spiritual, physical, artistic, and social emotional programmes across all year levels. The school community is enhanced through the provision of an Inclusion Support Centre and Early Learning Long Day Care facility catering for children from two years of age. Child centred classroom programmes are improved through interactive technology and an emphasis on the attainment of IT skills from the early years. The integration of the Auslan & Indigenous culture within the school is supported through the LOTE programme and opportunities for students to experience different forms of learning occur at all year levels.


