- Program: PLD spelling

- We concentrate on the sounds and breaking down of words as well as being able to explain the meaning of the word by writing it in a sentence, rather than rote learning 10 words.
- Weekly dictation tests
- Range of activities to reinforce spelling

MATHEMATICS

- Program: Origo
- Major Strands
 - Number & Algebra, Measurement & Geometry, Statistics and Probability, Times tables: 2, 3, 5, 10
- Children can work on the mat with teacher depending on their understanding of that strand/concept
- Problem solving and open-ended tasks
