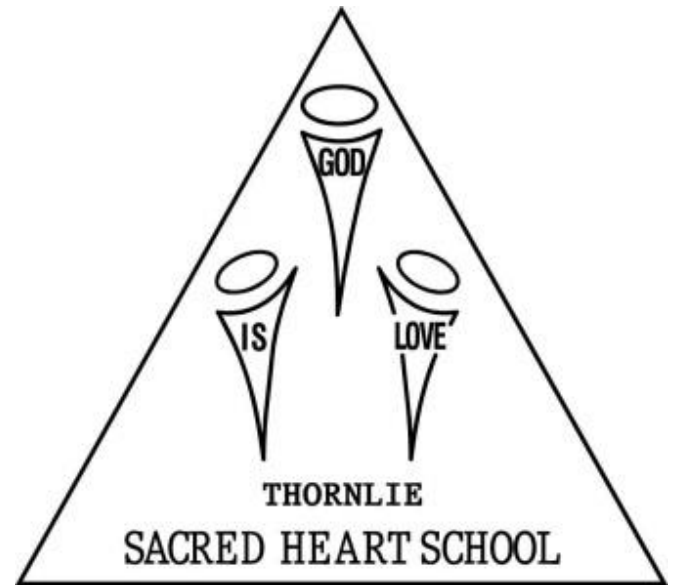

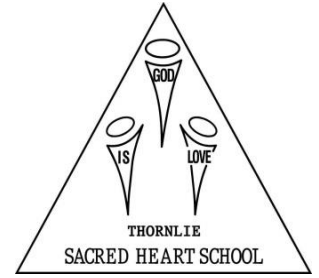

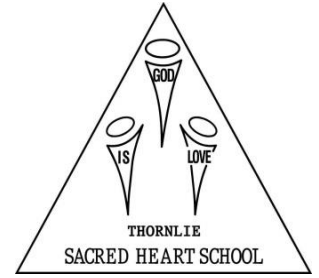

Behaviour Expectations

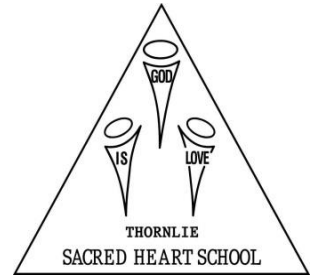
“Classroom Code of Conduct”

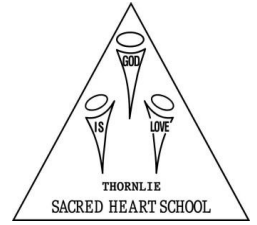
These are a set of rules written by the students and agreed upon by the whole class and the teacher.

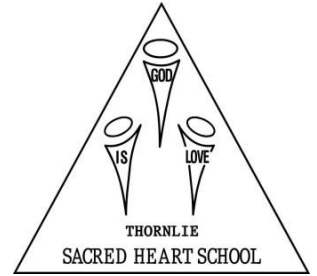
Teachers will respond to emails between 8am and 4pm on school days. Please allow up to 48hrs to respond.

We plan our programs of work to meet the requirements of the mandated Western Australian Curriculum



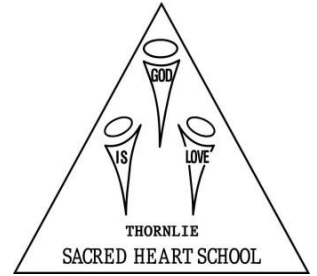

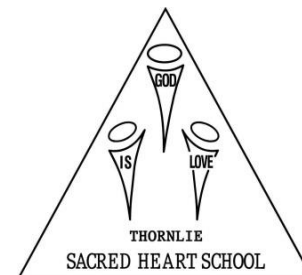


- Homework can be viewed on One Note each week.

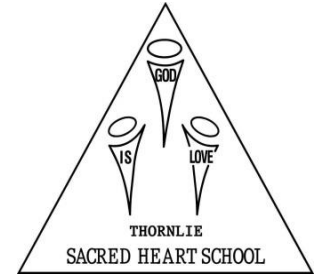

Camp:

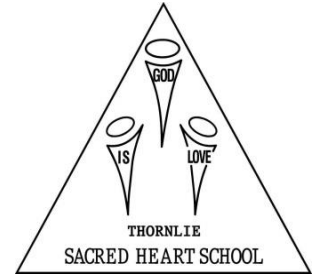


- Monday 22 April – Wednesday 24 April** (Term Two) at Woodman Point. Leadership and team-building focus.

Sacrament of Confirmation:

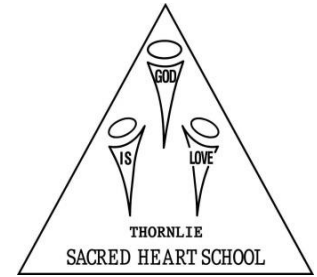


- Sacramental Commitment Mass – Saturday 16 March 6pm

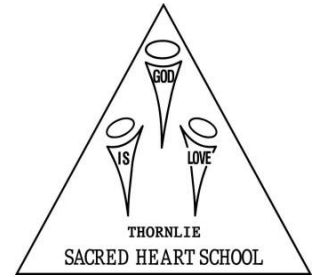

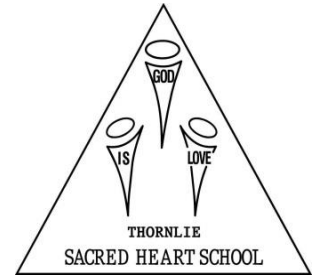

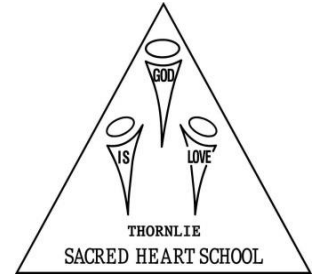
Graduation Shirts:
